Lacking indigenous resources, Armenia imports natural gas and oil for most of its energy needs (78.6% of total energy supply in 2020), mainly from the Russian Federation (hereafter, "Russia").

Why does Armenia need a single energy supplier?

Armenia relies on imports of natural gas and oil for most of its energy needs, which exposes it to supply risks and dependence on a single supplier. As the government considers energy security and the development of indigenous sources to be of prime importance for the energy sector, renewables and efficiency measures are key areas.

Is Armenia a net exporter of electricity?

Armenia has active interconnection infrastructure with Iran and Georgia and is a net exporter of electricity. Existing interconnections with Turkey and Azerbaijan are currently inactive. 1. How does Armenia import natural gas?

Natural gas is imported from Russia via pipeline through Georgia, but also from Iran through a barter agreement under which it exports electricity in exchange. Armenia also trades electricity with Georgia, though volumes are low since the countries' networks are not synchronised.
