What is compressed air energy storage?

Compressed air energy storage (CAES) is a promising energy storage technology due to its cleanliness, high efficiency, low cost, and long service life. What is energy storage & why is it important?

Energy storage (ES) plays a key role in the energy transition to low-carbon economies due to the rising use of intermittent renewable energy in electrical grids. Among the different ES technologies, compressed air energy storage (CAES) can store tens to hundreds of MW of power capacity for long-term applications and utility-scale.

What are the main components of a compressed air system?

The largest component in such systems is the storage medium for the compressed air. This means that higher pressure storage enables reduced volume and higher energy density.

How big is energy storage in 2022?

The total installed energy storage reached 209.4 GW worldwide in 2022, an increase of 9.0% over the previous year. CAES, another large-scale energy storage technology with pumped-hydro storage, demonstrates promise for research, development, and application. However, there are concerns about technical maturity, economy, policy, and so forth.

What is an example of a widespread storage technology deployment?

One example they mention is precisely CAES. The IEA Technology Roadmap states that the key to achieving widespread storage technology deployment is enabling compensation for multiple services delivered across the energy system.

China is currently in the early stage of commercializing energy storage. As of 2017, the cumulative installed capacity of energy storage in China was 28.9 GW [5], accounting for only 1.6% of the total power generating

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capacity (1777 GW [6]), which is still far below the goal set by the State Grid of China (i.e., 4%-5% by 2020) [7].

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The CAES project is designed to charge 498GWh of energy a year and output 319GWh of energy a year, a round-trip efficiency of 64%, but could achieve up to 70%, China Energy said. 70% would put it on par with flow batteries, while pumped hydro energy storage (PHES) can achieve closer to 80%.

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
