



# How long does it take to charge an outdoor power bank in Busan South Korea

How long does it take to charge a power bank?

The average charging time of a power bank depends on the capacity of the power bank and the charger used. Typically it takes 3 to 8 hours. What should you pay attention to when charging a power bank? Pay attention to the charger used, charging parameters and control smooth charging.

Should a power bank be charged first?

Depending on the charge level, you can start using them immediately or charge them first instead. While there is no set rule, it's okay to let the power bank's battery level reach around 20% before you charge it. Draining it completely may be fine temporarily, but don't leave it with an empty battery for long.
