

Do you need a power plug in Grenada?

In Grenada, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type G are used. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Yes, you need a power plug travel adapter for sockets type G in Grenada. You also need a voltage converter. Be extra careful with certain devices because of the difference in frequency. Do your power plugs fit in Grenada?

#### Do I need a travel adapter for Grenada power outlet?

It is important to determine if you need a travel adapter or a voltage converter for Grenada plug and power outlets. Not to worry, we have all the information you need to ensure a problem-free trip. #### What type of power socket is used in Grenada?

You need a voltage converter in Grenada to protect your devices! The standard voltage in Grenada (230 V) is much higher than the voltage level your devices typically operate at in the United States (120 V). Without a converter, you risk serious damage to your devices. Additionally, be aware that the frequency in Grenada differs.
