Are power banks banned in South Korea?

South Korea implemented nationwide restrictions that took effect this month, banning passengers from storing power banks and e-cigarettes in overhead cabins on all of the country's airlines. Passengers can store power banks either in the seat pocket or under the seat.

What is a PD power bank & PD wireless charging power bank?

The company has announced the PD Power Bank 20,000mAh and PD Wireless Charging Power Bank 10,000mAh. Both of these portable battery packs arrive in a single Beige color option and are built using 30 percent recycled plastic materials. However, as reported by The Korea Herald, a passenger suggested that a "crackling sound" could be heard emanating from an overhead luggage compartment, with an Air Busan official quoted in local media reports as stating that the fire "appears to have been caused by a passenger"s portable power bank, compressed inside the overhead bin".

New regulations on carrying portable battery chargers on board aircraft have been put into place, according to the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport Tuesday. Passengers will need to attach insulation tape to the ports of portable battery chargers and if taping is difficult, chargers must be carried in a transparent plastic bag.
