What does E4 mean on an air conditioner?

This code tells you that the air conditioner unit is defrosting. An air conditioner will display the E4 error code because the unit needs to defrost. What does e2 mean on my Culligan water softener? E2 code is "motor stuck"; Could be a dead motor or the motor could be bound up or the gears (or piston) the motor is trying to drive are bound or if applicable, the motor locating pin may have sheared off.

E4: Unit has a tank built-in that must be emptied periodically. E4 indicates the tank float is stuck. Open the water tank and verify no debris is blocking the operation of the float. STOP: Unit has a tank built-in that must be emptied periodically. STOP indicates the tank must be emptied or tank float is stuck. Unit will not run while STOP appears.
